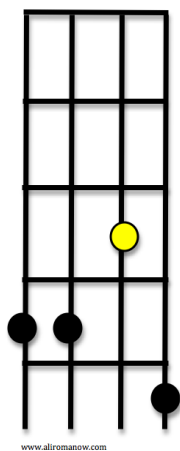

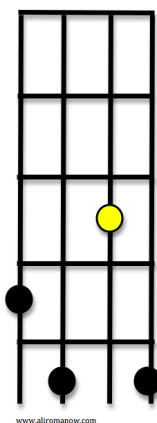
When in doubt, go back to G6 and hang out there.
